
## Allochernes powelli



The cephalothorax and pedipalps are red-brown and the opisthosoma yellow-brown. *Allochernes powelli* is found in W. Europe: England, Denmark, NW. Spain. There are scattered records from England and Wales where it is probably under-recorded; it has not been recorded from Scotland. This mainly synanthropic species occurs in barn and stable refuse. The cephalothorax is strongly granulate, longer than broad and with two distinct transverse grooves. Eyes are absent. Length of body: 2. 2-2. 3mm
