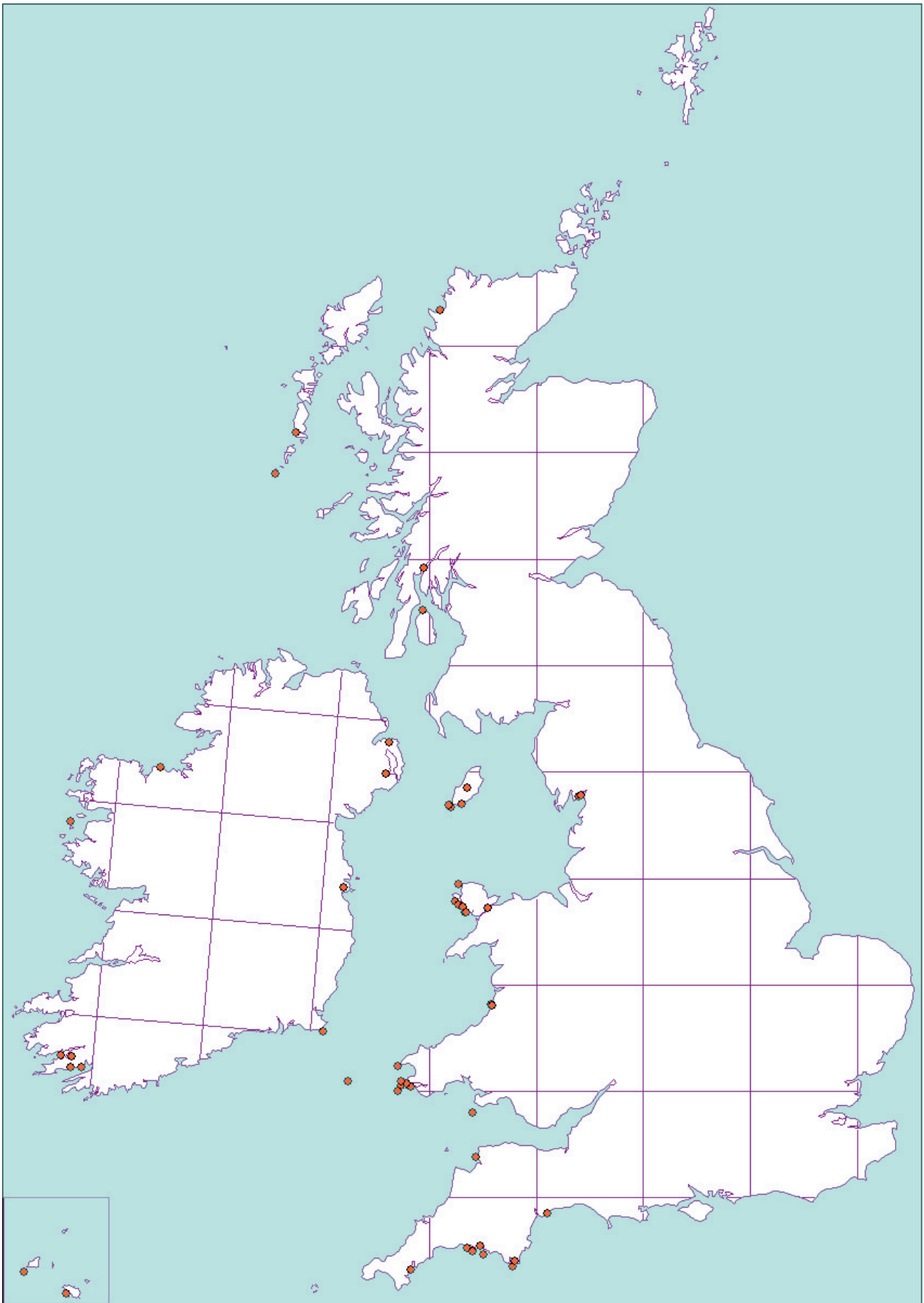


Neobisium maritimum



The cephalothorax and opisthosomal tergites are deep olive-brown; the pedipalp rich olive-brown; legs greenish. Distribution: Europe: Atlantic coast of Ireland, England, W. France. In Britain there are a few scattered records from SW. Cornwall, SW. Wales, the Isle of Man, the Isle of Wight, Anglesey and the coast of Ireland *N. maritimum* is found in rock crevices and under stones from the top of the upper shore and in the splash zone, down into the *Ascophyllum* zone. Length of body: 3.2mm.
