Roncocreagris cambridgei



Colour: Cephalothorax reddish-brown tinged with olive; opisthosomal tergites olive-cream, and the; pedipalps reddish-brown. Distribution: Europe: Atlantic margin of Spain (including S. Andalucia), Portugal, N. and W. France, and S. England. In Britain this species has a distinctly westerly distribution, from NW. Scotland to Cornwall along to Hampshire. There are records also from SW. and Northern Ireland. It favours deciduous tree litter and grass, but can also be found beneath stones on the coast and some distance inland. Length of body: 2. 5-3. 0mm.
